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Outcomes of the Meeting:

Agenda item 1 – Welcome to Country and the meeting and previous meeting actions

Matthew Cooke delivered Welcome to Country.

Action items from previous meetings were reviewed.

Agenda item 2 - Independent Science Panel Updates

Dr Ian Poiner, presented updates regarding:

- the progress of GHHP ISP projects mapping and synthesis; conceptual modelling; report card literature review; and the community perception survey.
- an outline of what is a report card, how the GHHP vision for the Gladstone Harbour will be used and how the indicators will be selected;
- a request for clarification from the ISP to the GHHP about the use of the GHHP report card findings with a suggestion of the development of a GHHP user needs statement; and
- The link between the mapping and synthesis project and duplication and gaps analysis.

Dr Poiner referred to the update provided by Dr Llyndon Llewellyn from AIMS (in the workshop prior to the GHHP meeting) about the mapping and synthesis exercise to date.

The Partnership discussed the importance of receiving the Mapping and Synthesis Project Report duplication and gaps analysis to inform partner monetary contribution discussions.

Agenda item 3 - GHHP General Business

Communication Plan/Strategy for Stage Two

Mr Ian McGoldrick, from Rio Tinto presented the Communications Working Group's recommended Communication Plan for stage two of GHHP. The Communication Plan is broken into three sections - Must Haves, Should Haves and Nice to Haves. The Plan was endorsed as a provisional plan for further consideration by the management committee once established.

Governance Models Discussion and Required steps from now until formalisation in September 2013

Ms Sue-Ern Tan from QCLNG presented the Funding Model and Governance Working Groups recommendations to the GHHP. The following steps were agreed to move towards a formalised GHHP by the end of September 2013:

- 1) GHHP governance charter endorsed.
- 2) Type of entity for the GHHP endorsed as being hosted with Fitzroy Basin Association for at least the first year.
- 3) Duplication and gaps analysis to be completed and delivered to GHHP from GHHP ISP by mid-August 2013.
- 4) GHHP's vision for a Healthy Harbour to be endorsed out of session by mid-August 2013.



- 5) Interim Management Committee to be established by mid-August 2013 (following ISP communication to the GHHP re monitoring/research duplication and gaps analysis).
- 6) Interim Management Committee to draft a provisional budget and circulate to GHHP by mid-September 2013.
- 7) GHHP approval of on provisional budget and formalisation of GHHP by end of September 2013.

Agenda item 4 - Community Updates

Councillor Col Chapman updated the Partnership on Gladstone Region Environment Network (GREAN) activities since the last meeting.

GREAN:

- Met with the ISP to formalise the GREAN/ISP relationship and agreed on a way forward.
- Drafted the agenda paper documenting the decisions regarding the recommendation presented at meeting 3 for a harbour oral history compilation.
- Endorsed the Boyne Island Environmental Education Centre's application to an LNG company for a "Harbour Watch" program for students and broader community. Col emphasised the linkages between this program and the GHHP.

The Secretariat updated the Partnership that a traditional owner workshop will be held in early September 2013 to discuss cultural values and traditional owner representation on the GHHP.
